



ICD-10 Coding Tip

OSHPD Reporting of HIV Codes

In an effort to aid Health Information Management Coding and Medical Billing Professionals with ICD-10, the following training tip is provided with an educational intent.

OSHPD's reporting requirements for HIV codes will remain the same in ICD-10

HIV Positive Test Results: Codes for HIV positive test results reported in data sent to OSHPD currently receive a warning edit flag SW05 (Principal Dx Field) and SW06 (Secondary Dx Field). The same edits will be applied for ICD-10 equivalent codes

V08	Asymptomatic human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection status	Z21	Asymptomatic human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection status
795.71	Nonspecific serologic evidence of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)	R75	Inconclusive laboratory evidence of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)

Human Immunodeficiency Virus [HIV] Disease: Code may be reported to OSHPD according to physician documentation in the medical record.

Current ICD-9 Codes	Code Description	ICD-10 Equivalent Codes	Code Description
042	Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) disease	B20	Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) disease

Contact with or Suspected Exposure: Code may be reported to OSHPD since it does not reveal HIV test results

Current ICD-9 Codes	Code Description	ICD-10 Equivalent Codes	Code Description
V01.79	Contact with or exposure to other viral diseases	Z20.6	Contact with and (suspected) exposure to human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)
